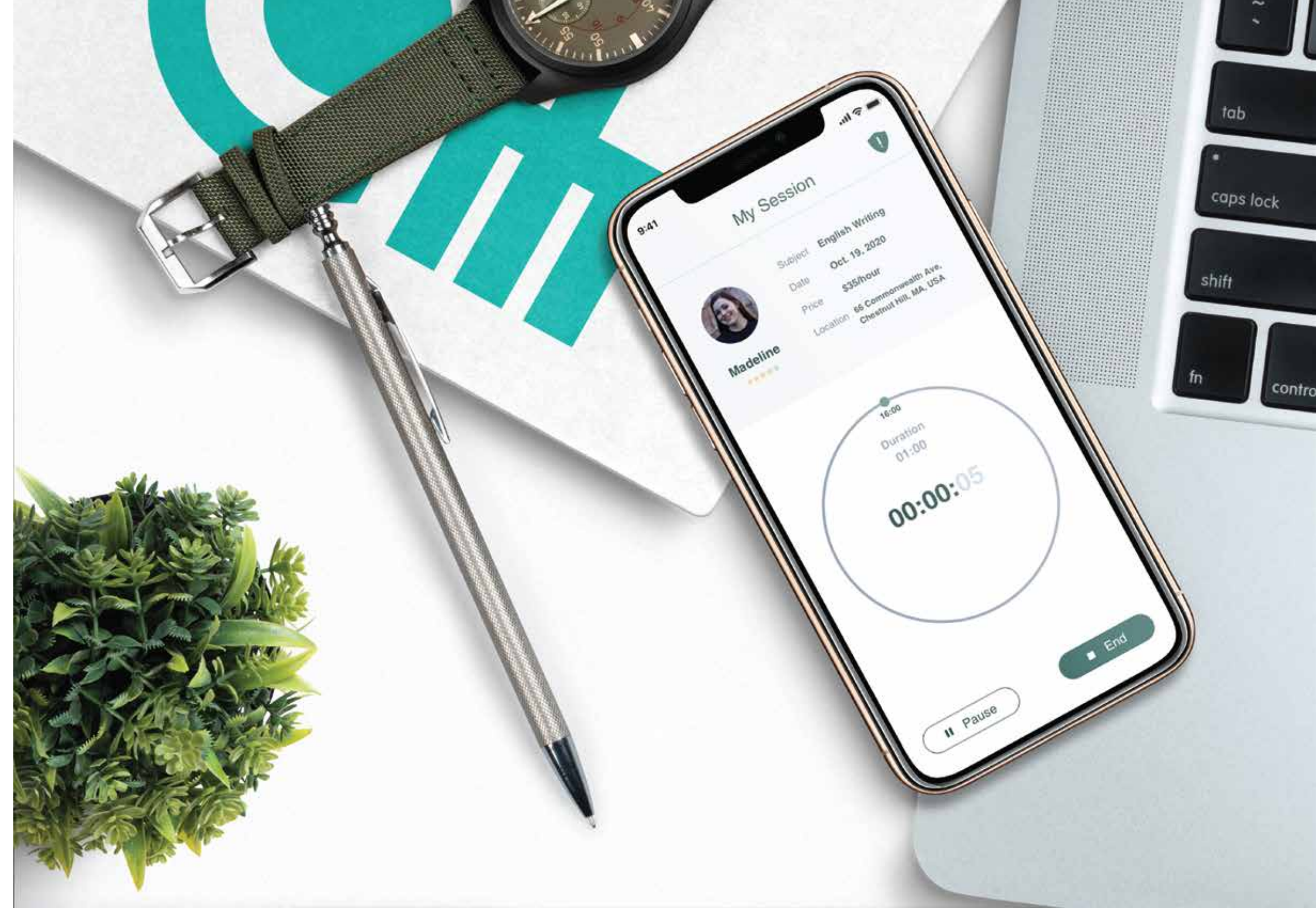

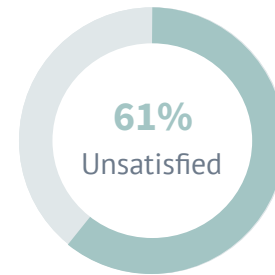
I was in charge of product iterations, marketing campaign and event organizations, target user research, and competitor research.



## BACKGROUND

In today, most college students are facing the pressure of heavy workloads, challenging passing requirements, and the highly self-study oriented class culture. More college students tend to seek help from outside of classroom. Most schools have facilities such as learning centers with tutors' supports.

According to our market research involving 320 college students from 60 universities in the U.S. Over half of the students surveyed are **unsatisfied** with existing tutoring services and are seeking alternatives.



Within the unsatisfied group,

**37%** of are due to the unqualified tutor at school learning center

**32%** are because of the low availability that school offers, especially during exam period.

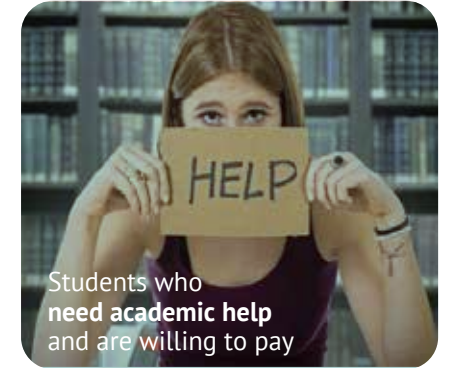

Our **target customers** are college students who need academic help and those who want to be tutors.

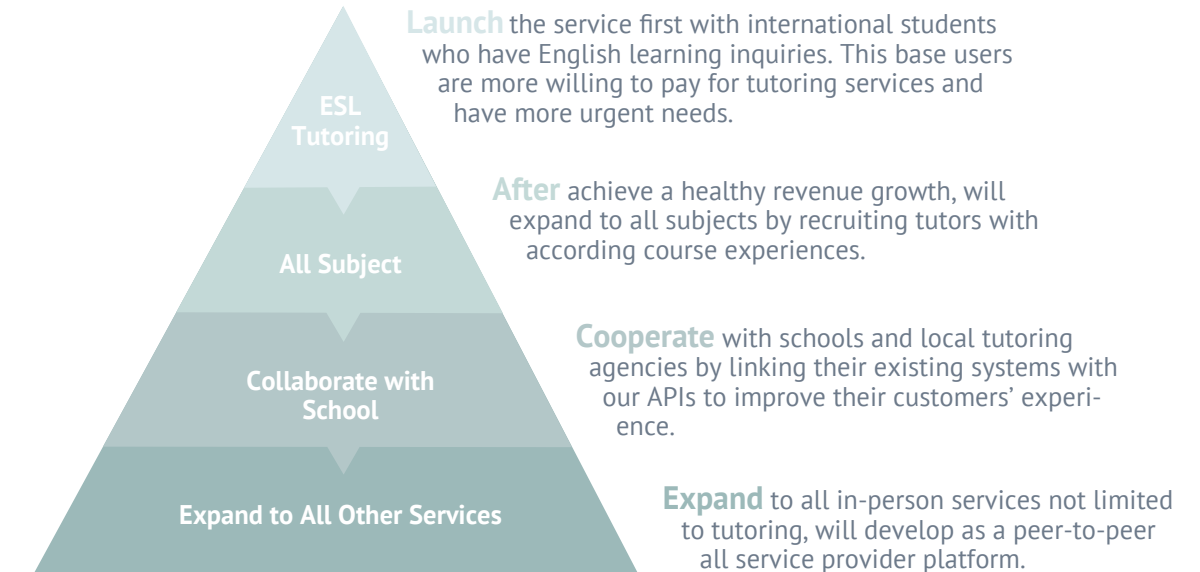

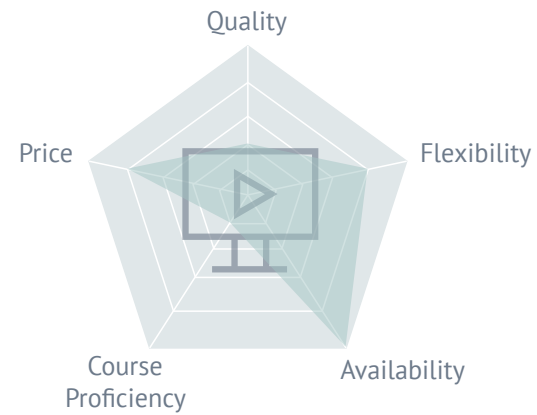

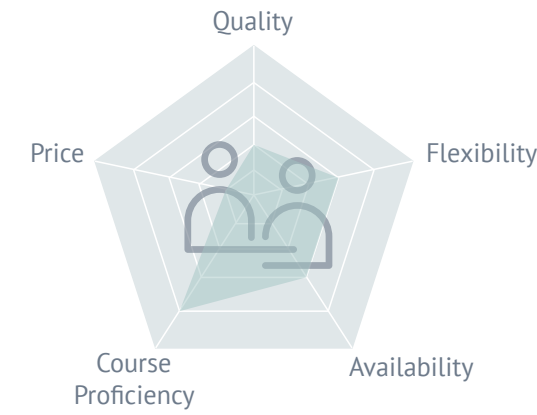
## Competitive Analysis

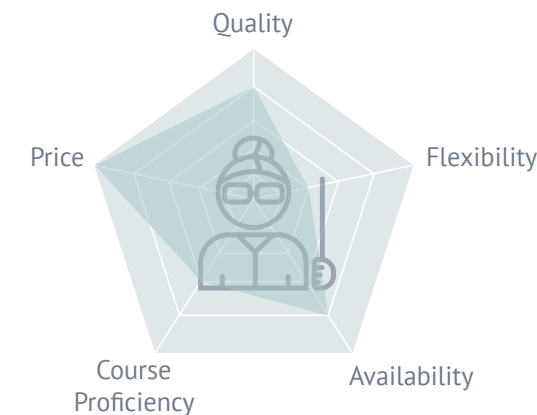

## SWOT Analysis

In order to better understand our current position and status in the tutoring market, we made the SWOT analysis to establish a clearer definition of where we are in the market.

### Strength

- Provide easy entry for both tutor and tutee, an easier way to earn money for tutors and helps those who can pay.
- Hire in-school student tutor who can teach catering to particular school course
- Instantaneous matching
- There is no mature product in this field which resolves similar problems launched on market yet.

### Opportunity

- Launch in the Great Boston Area college campus first where is still a vacant market for this product
- Cooperate with schools' learning centers and local tutoring agencies by linking their existing systems with our front-end application and our back-end API to improve their customers' experience and to promote their services

### Weakness

- Compared to School learning center it is unofficial and less well-know, has lower credibility
- Requires a fee for each session, while school offers free teaching

### Threats

- Difficult to recruit users from each school in a short time
- Expansion requires more investments
- Rely on word of mouth marketing when recruiting tutees.

# USER RESEARCH

## Research Method

### Build App

Built a mock app based on the prototype for users to experience the full features of the product.



### Record

The users say what step they are taking, and I record their behaviors and comments.

### Frustrations

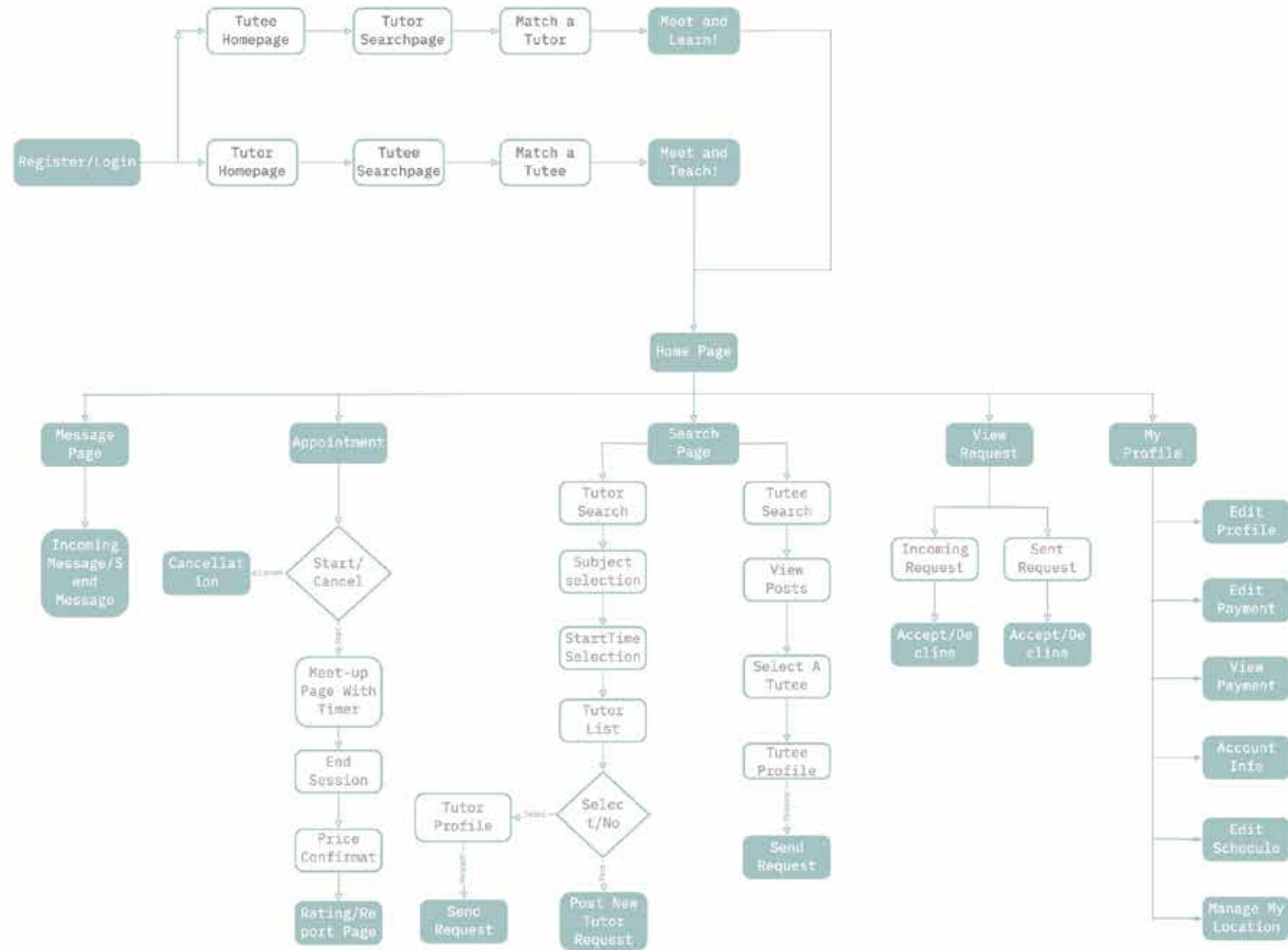
During exam periods, the school tutors are always overbooked, and their qualities are not reliable, plus TAs are busy when visiting their office hours.

Change

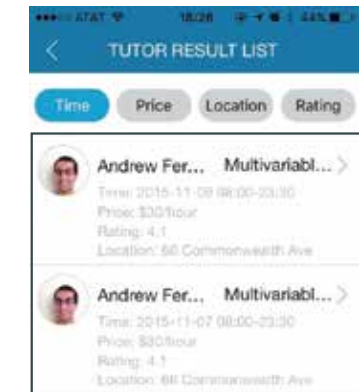
Users are hesitated to give out card information before fully understand the platform. This change will give users more time to trust the app.

## Search Page

Emphasize the key information: make them more noticeable. Reduce the steps: stay on the same page to view full information of the tutor. Re-do the filtering mechanism.

Make the tutor selecting easier and more clear. Reduce the tedious steps to help users make decisions faster.

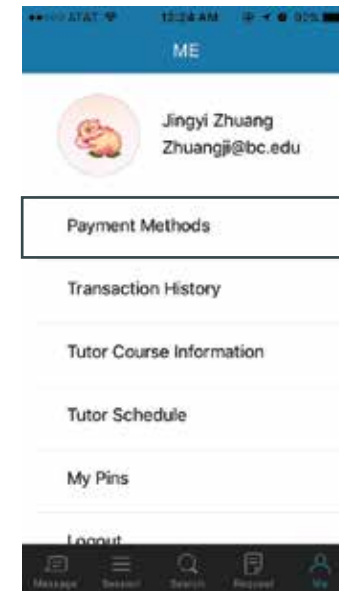
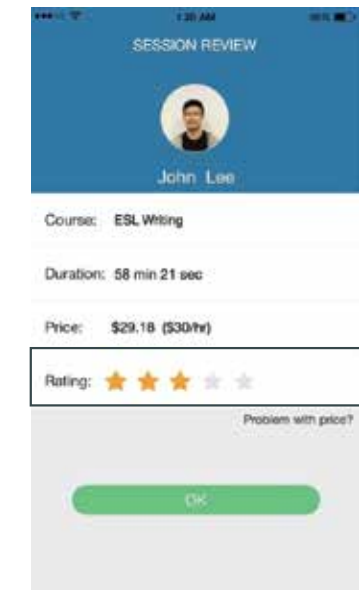
Users most care about tutor's quality. These changes will provide more straightforward and detailed information about the tutor's quality.

Text review will provide more complete information for the future tutee/tutors, also offers an opportunity for users to show their appreciation/complaints.

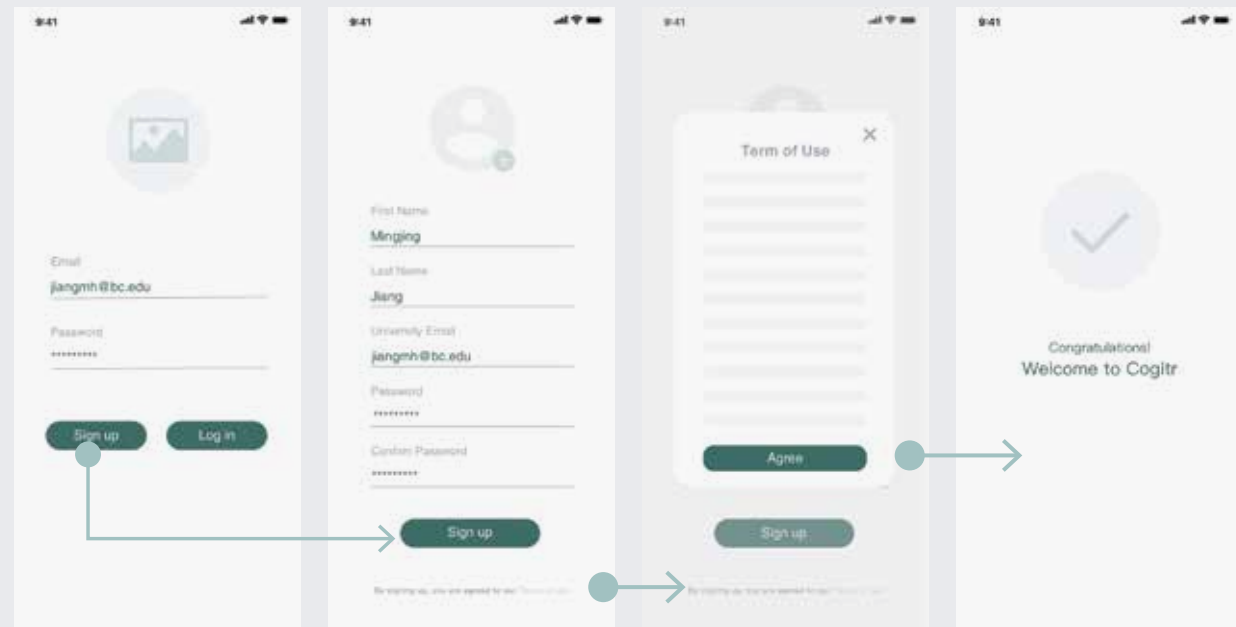
